Welcome Back

ParentPay

Everyone should now have ParentPay access. If you pay for school dinners (Year 3 upwards) then this needs to be paid in advance. We suggest routinely paying on a Sunday evening for the forthcoming week. If a day is missed due to illness then this can be knocked off the following week's amount. School dinners cost £2.30 per day or £11.50 for the week.
